

YEAR 11 SCIENCE INTERVENTION

As part of our ongoing support for pupils, the science department will be running after-school boosters for pupils in Year 11. Attendance at these boosters is compulsory. The boosters are designed to address any gaps in knowledge that your child may have. In the first instance these sessions will focus on content that will be featured in the November mock exams.

Regularly we will evaluate the needs of Year 11 and amend the list of pupils, depending on their need and the topics being addressed. We will of course keep you informed of times/ dates when we require your child to attend.

The initial booster programme **requires your child to attend from 3:05-4pm starting Monday 28 September**. All students will be based in the Main Hall and will be required to follow a given seating plan.

We do expect all pupils invited to attend but also realise that students may have appointments, etc. already booked. If this is the case then pupils must communicate this with their science teacher before the start of the session. There are sanctions for students who do not attend and have not been to see us before the session. We do not expect to have to use these as this is to support pupils learning so please support us with this.

Failure to attend intervention when invited:

If students don't attend they will be issued with *2 half hour lunchtime detentions – this makes up for the hour that they have missed.

If students don't turn up to the lunchtime detentions then they will go to connect for a day.

Failure to attend *3 interventions then this is passed to Mr Fieldhouse and Mr Miller who will invite parents in.
