- 2: Pencil or pen to draw if required
- 3: Personal choice - Coloured pencils, felt pens, bits and bobs to decorate
- 4: Lollipop sticks or card strips to hold and make your puppet dance
- 5: Glue or staples to attach all pieces together
- 6: Scissors to cut out - Health and Safety - careful of your fingers.
- 7: Camera or a phone to photograph your magnificent dragon puppet

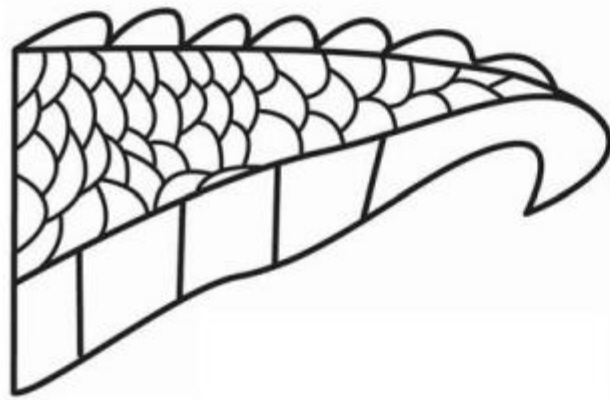
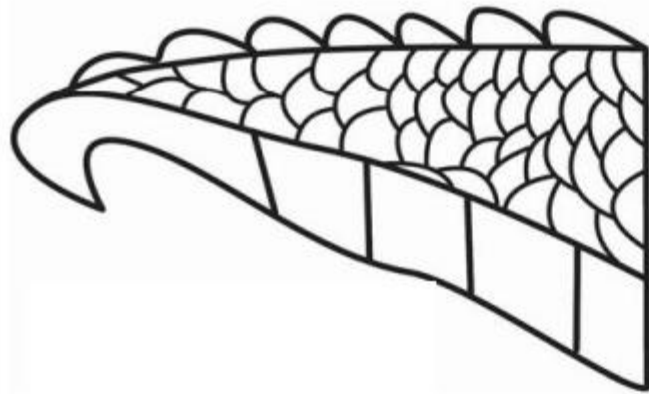

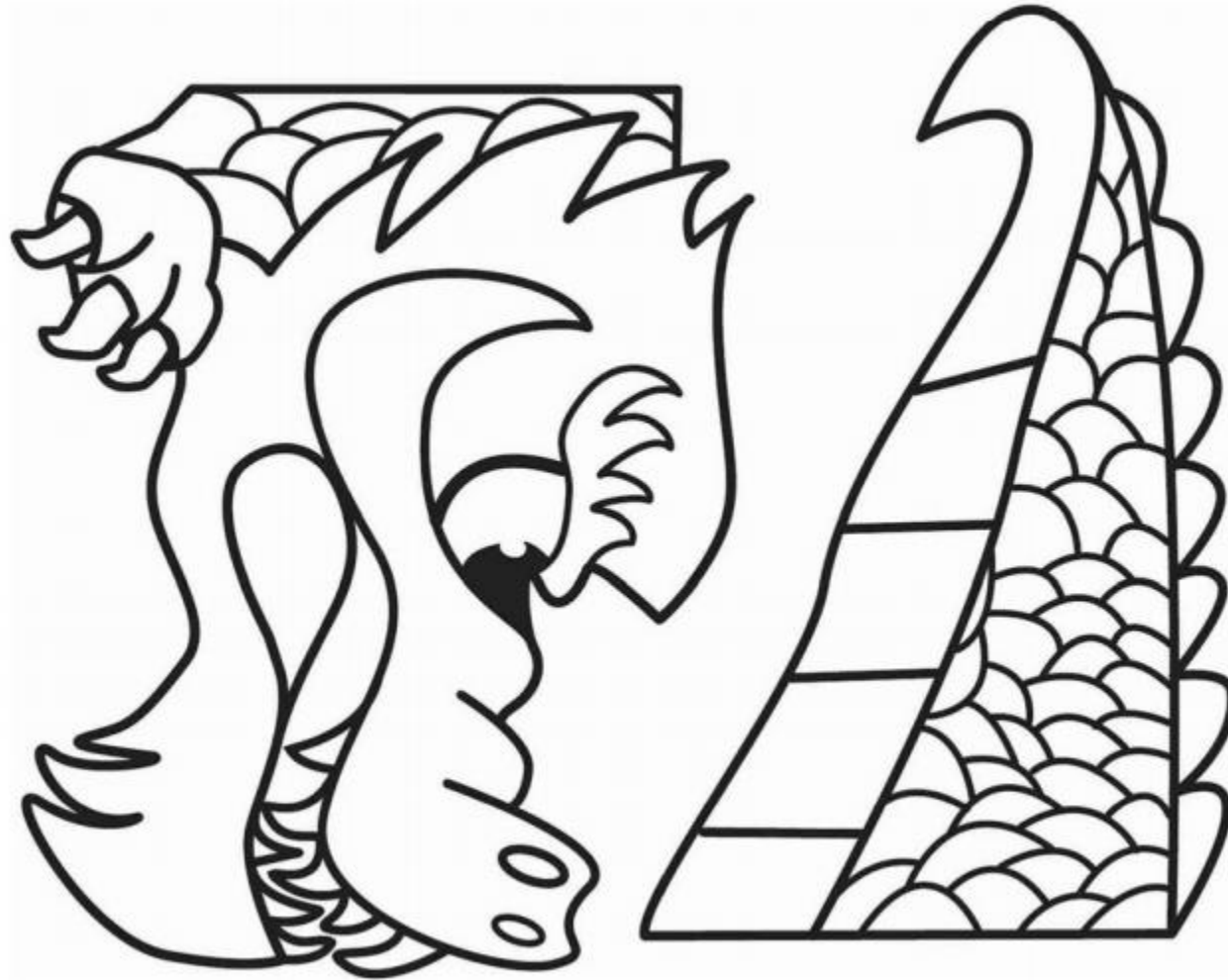
Step by Step

- 1: *Draw , print slides or cut out your chosen dragon head, tail and legs.
Check you have room to attach the dragon body behind head and tail.*
 - 2: Add colour to head, tail and feet. Decorate - be creative
 - 3: Cut 2 strips of paper, that match the size of your dragon head and tail.
Check width before you cut.. White paper ? - colour and decorate.
 - 4: Fold the body of your dragon. *See following slides for folding ideas*
 - 5: Attach the head , tail and feet to your dragon body
 - 6: Add 2 pieces of card or lollipop sticks to help move your dragon
- Before you start - look at all the slides again - the head and tail must measure the same height/ width as the paper strips you cut. to fold.for the body**

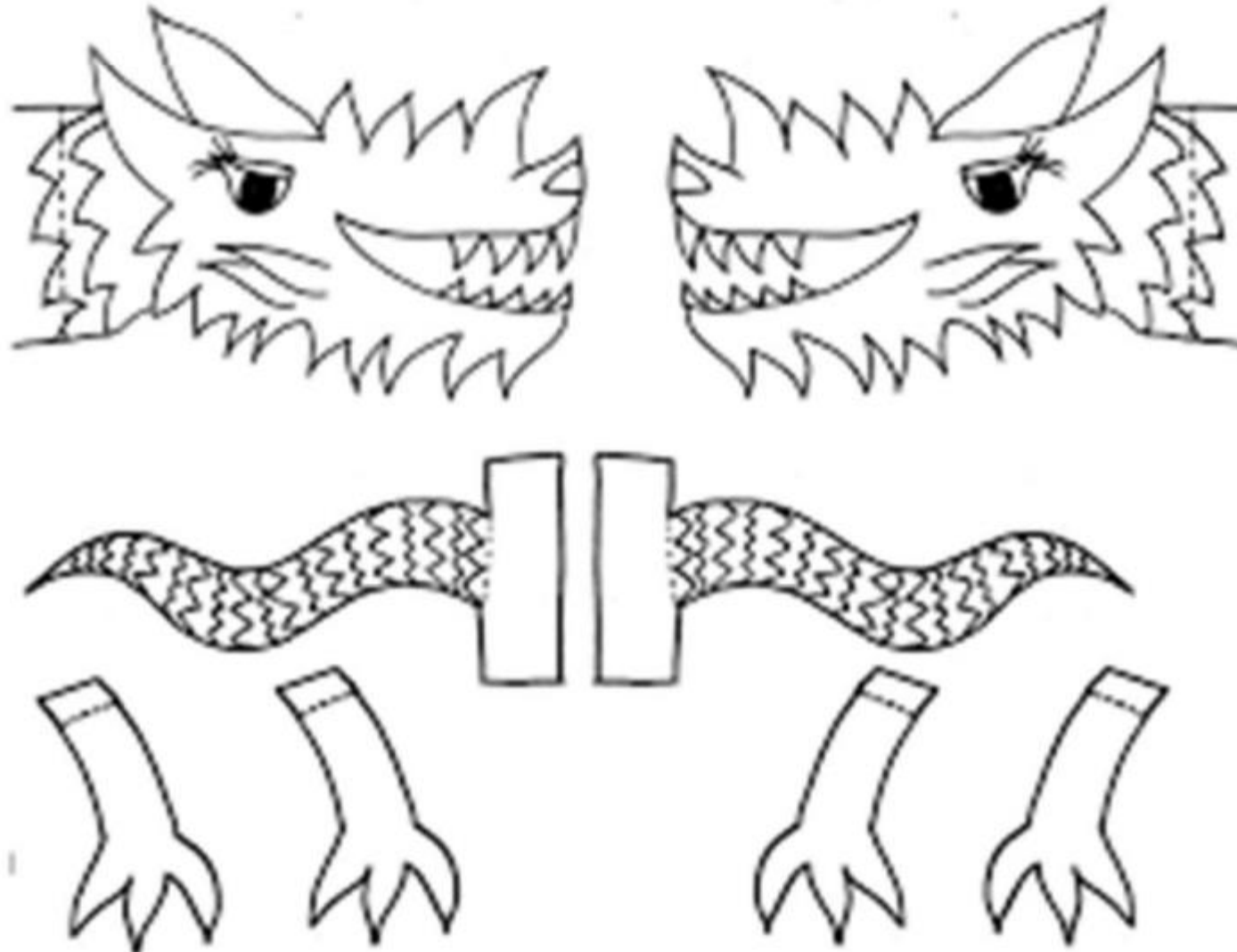
