PRISON ME NO WAY – YEAR 10 WEDNESDAY 28 APRIL

Year 10 pupils are to be given the opportunity to experience an innovative day as part of their Values curriculum. This will be run by Prison Me! No Way! who are a national educational charity with a core aim of raising awareness among young people about the causes, consequences and penalties of crime.

This will be a 'drop down day' when pupils will take part in a variety of interactive workshops throughout the school day.


I hope that this day will help our pupils to recognise the risky behaviour that can lead to serious criminal consequences and help them consider how they can manage their decisions in the future. The workshops are shown below:

Workshops

1. County lines – what it is, how it works and how to stay safe.
2. Askham Hall– A serving prisoner talking about life choices and daily life in prison. This will take place remotely via Microsoft Teams.
3. Prison Van – A look at what a prison cell looks like, true to size.
4. Knife crime – The consequences associated with carrying a knife.
5. The impact of choices – from one punch can kill, domestic violence awareness or Jenny's story.
